Winter Uniform begins on Wednesday, November 1st.

Boys PK-7th: White button-down oxford with school logo, navy pants with a plain black, brown, or navy belt, school sweater or fleece with logo, white or navy socks and dress shoes (PK & K may wear white tennis shoes year-round)

Boys 8th: Light blue button-down oxford with school logo, khaki pants with a plain black, brown, or navy belt, school sweater or fleece with logo, white or navy socks and dress shoes

Girls PK-7th: White button-down oxford with school logo, navy pants with a plain black, brown, or navy belt, school sweater or fleece with logo, white or navy socks and dress shoes (PK & K may wear white tennis shoes year-round)

Girls 8th: Light blue button-down oxford with school logo, khaki pants with a plain black, brown, or navy belt, school sweater or fleece with logo, white or navy socks and dress shoes

Girls may also wear school plaid jumper or skirt (no skorts) with white blouse. White or navy tights may be worn.

Shirts without logo must have a school sweater or fleece over them.P
