All are welcome to join us this Saturday at the 5:30 evening Mass for our second graders' First Communion.

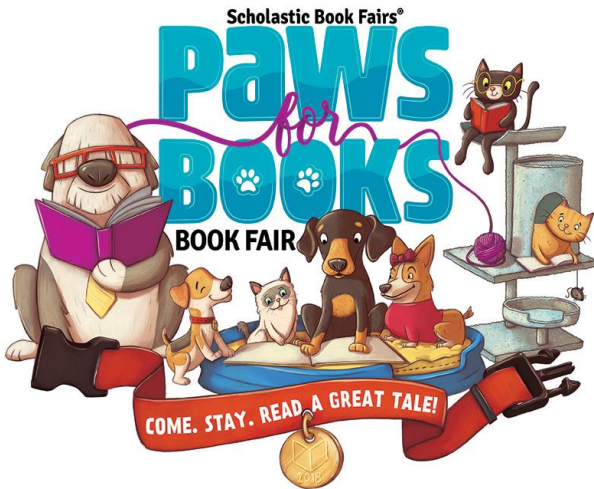
Don't forget, no school next Friday, April 20th. Teachers will be renewing their First Aid/CPR certification.
