The teachers are grateful to all those who were able to volunteer today so that we could enjoy a faculty luncheon.

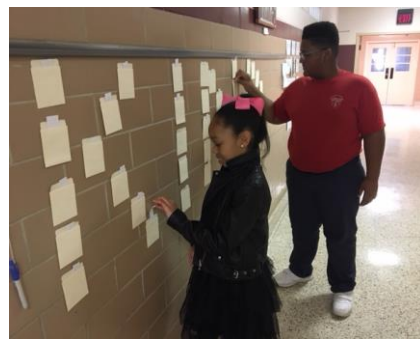


We hope to see all our parents Saturday, February 10th for an evening of fun!
