Stations of the Cross

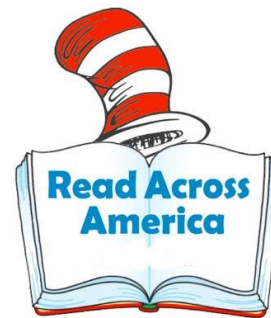
We'd love for you to join our school students on Fridays when we pray the Stations of the Cross.
